He will also address the current challenges of operating an American club abroad, including security considerations and member engagement, in today's geopolitical climate.



An American expatriate living in Europe since 1982 and in Geneva since 1994, Ron is a seasoned marketing professional, entrepreneur, and educator with extensive international experience. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Marketing and an MBA, has worked with multinational FMCG companies in the U.S. and Europe, and is a founding partner of four Geneva-based companies. In addition, he serves as an Adjunct Professor of Marketing at a U.S. university in Geneva and is actively involved in nonprofit leadership, including roles with American Citizens Abroad and the Association of American Clubs.
